Contemporary witness Harry Bibring in Vienna

In April, **Harry Bibring** visited Vienna upon the invitation of the **Jewish Welcome Service** in cooperation with the **Holocaust Memorial Service** (Verein GEDENKDIENST). As a 14 year-old, Bibring fled to England with his sister as a part of "Kindertransport" (Refugee Children Movement). His parents were deported from **Vienna Aspang station** and did not survive. As a contemporary witness, he took part in a **memorial event** for Jom haSchoa at the former Vienna Aspang station, where trains left for the Nazi extermination camps with thousands of Viennese Jews. President of the IKG **Oskar Deutsch**, City Councillor for Culture **Andreas Mailath-Pokorny** and head of the Austrian railway network (ÖBB) **Christian Kern** remembered the deportations to Nazi extermination camps.
